

Pastor's Pcn- Welcome Letter from Pastor Brian

I am delighted to be entering into the exciting work of shepherding as part of the pastoral team at St. Timothy's. God called me to this congregation to help continue the work that has already begun by Pastor Dan, Pastor Judy, Pastor Jim, Elizabeth and Joe to "Know the Father, Grow as disciples of Jesus, and Go with the Spirit."

While the call to pastoral ministry for me will be a full-time endeavor, I hope the congregation recognizes the ministry and life partner the Lord has given me in my wife, Debi. She and I together have served in ministry helping pastors and their church leadership teams soar to new heights by building cultures of relational, life-on-life discipleship. We know what a difference life-on-life discipleship makes. As we look ahead further into 2017, we want to be completely available to God and to the people He desires us to reach and transform with His love here at St. Tim's and throughout the San Jose community.

For over 10 years, the Tampa-Clearwater community blessed us with the opportunity to serve through Clearwater Community Church, Dream Center Metro and The Navigators. We participated in guiding many outreach and ministry opportunities throughout the Tampa area. In addition, the NALC gave us the opportunity over the past four years to serve churches through the NC-SC-GA-FL regions as they sought to grow discipleship in their communities.

We give praise for the missionary journey Debi and I have been on with The Navigators for the past five years, engaging with pastors and ministry leaders worldwide with NCM Life & Leadership coaching and embracing NCM's Growing intentional Disciplemaking Cultures process. God has shown us that pastors want more for their church members than simply Sunday worship and fellowship programs. They recognize that disconnected programs have no lasting effect, and that connected, relational discipleship is a meaningful part of spiritual growth. We have leveraged many resources to help these churches to multiply disciples in their churches and community.

We now look forward to taking a similar journey here in the San Jose area as the Lord guides our work at St. Timothy's. I hope to continue nourish and build a disciple-making culture as part of the ministry leadership – recognizing that it takes more than a plan or a program. We will need to come together, intentionally and actively, as a leadership team to continue to transform our culture toward growing disciples—spiritually and relationally—life-on-life.

Several years ago, we had shared a prayer card with the leadership team at one church we have been alongside in the NALC Carolinas mission district as we began the journey with them. On the card was the ministry verse that the Lord has given us to guide our hearts and minds - 1 Thessalonians 2:8, which reads, "So we care for you. Because we loved you so much, we were delighted to share with you not only the gospel of God but our lives as well."

Just this week, we received a letter from the leadership team thanking us for our missionary work in their community and throughout this nation, thanking us for our partnership and friendship. In the letter, they continued:

"You guys are family that now live in California. I want you to know that we see this (1 Thess. 2:8) in you and your ministry. You inspire others to be enthusiastic about becoming devoted disciples, align all your actions and words to God's principles, and are Spirit-led; sharing your lives and Christ's love with all you come in contact with. The ladies were not able to be with us during the planting due to their class schedule but they returned in time to join us for a dedicatory prayer.

Betsy went up last week to check on the plants and found everything growing well, except for the beans which were probably nibbled away by the bugs. We replanted the beans and weeded out few invaders. Next week we should be able to lay down more newspaper and straw mulch around the new plants. The ladies are very enthusiastic and learned how to "pinch" out the side shoots on the tomato plants so they don't get out of control. Mickey has some tomatillo plants that will be ready to go in very soon to complete the salsa garden.

The ladies of House of Grace are extremely grateful for our efforts as a congregation for building the garden area and learning a new skill that will hopefully help them stay clean and independent when they graduate the program.

disciples. It is my prayer that God will continue to use both of you, and your ministry, to pursue significance in California and throughout His kingdom."
