

Pastor's Pen

As I am writing this article, we are in the middle of our Vacation Bible School week. As with every year, this one is no exception. It is one of the most exciting and rewarding and energizing weeks of the entire year. With more than 250 children, another 240 Junior High, High School and adult volunteers, the opportunities for growth and maturity and real-life change are evident.

It is also a week that requires more energy and effort from a broader segment of our community than almost anything else we do throughout the year. As inspiring as it is to see it happen, and as encouraging as it is to watch the faith community in action, it is also a clear reminder of the need we have, as followers of Jesus, to set aside time each day to be renewed and refreshed in our faith, and to be strengthened and to grow in our relationship with God.

As I reflect on the importance of slowing down and spending time with God, and as I consider the things in front of us here at the church, I want to remind you and ask you to spend time this summer praying about the things that are happening during these next few months. Prayer moves the hand of God. Prayer empowers Christ's Church to carry out its work. In no order of priority, the following are opportunities for us to pray: First, after more than seven years of fulltime ministry on our staff, Joe Hill will be taking a ten-week sabbatical beginning on June 28 and continuing through the first week of September. During this time he will be taking a full load of classes at Fuller Seminary, working toward a degree that will prepare him for pastoral ministry. He has one year of seminary classes left before his internship. This sabbatical break will allow him to step back from his normal work load and make some good progress on completing his course studies. During this time, two of our own members will be supporting the ministries with which Joe is involved. Zoe Stamos will be serving as our Contemporary Worship Leader, and Aaron Gabel will be

working with our High School Youth Ministry. Be praying for

Zoe and Aaron, as well as for Joe, during this sabbatical break.

Second, be praying for the members of our Pastoral Call Team, elected by the congregation to serve: Larry Austin, Judy Bangsund, Michelle Donaldson, Aaron Gabel, Tammie Mark, Tony Mazzucco, and Wayne Peterson. The team began its work in June and will continue until a call is extended to the next pastor on our staff. Be praying for God's wisdom and will to be evident to each of the seven members of the team. Be praying also for God's Holy Spirit to prepare the heart of the pastor he is raising up to serve as one of the shepherds for our congregational flock.

Third, be praying for our Christian Preschool and for our new director, Jeanette Adams. There is another article in this newsletter, introducing Jeanette to our community. As you have opportunity, welcome her to our church family and encourage her in her new calling. Be praying also for increased enrollment and for an expanded opportunity through our preschool to shape and mold young lives for Jesus.

Finally, be praying for the North American Lutheran Church (NALC) as it prepares to elect a new National Bishop at its August 7-9 Convocation in Indianapolis, IN. After eight years of service, Bishop John Bradosky will be retiring. Twelve candidates have been nominated for that position, of which I am one of the twelve. I ask for your prayers for God's wisdom and will, along with the moving of his Holy Spirit, to make clear to the Convocation the person of God's choosing.

The summer months are oftentimes a bit different, providing greater opportunity for rest and renewal, for slowing down and being renewed and refreshed. Regardless of what your summer might include, I ask you to join me in setting aside time each day to pray for your church family and for the things God has set before us. Prayer moves the hand of God. Prayer empowers Christ's Church to carry out its work. I pray that God's power and his moving hand will be at work in us.




