# Special Congregational Meeting on November 15

Back during 2019, before we had heard of something called COVID-19, the Leadership Council formed a team to change St. Timothy's Constitution and Bylaws to reflect the closing of the Academy and the continuation of the Preschool. As those changes were made, it also became apparent that other changes would be helpful to improve structure and clarity. The revised Constitution and Bylaws were just being completed when the pandemic arrived.

The pandemic disclosed another issue. Under our current Constitution, certain congregational business (such as calling a pastor), can only be conducted by physically gathering and voting with paper ballots. As we have seen, this is a difficult requirement to meet when gatherings are restricted for health reasons. It therefore seems advisable to permit the Leadership Council to organize a "virtual meeting" to conduct essential business if a physical meeting cannot be held.

The Leadership Council has recently reviewed a scaled-back set of changes to the Constitution and Bylaws that we feel will be a suitable intermediate step toward the full set of changes that are ultimately needed. These changes are limited to two areas: 1) matters dealing with closing the Academy while retaining the Preschool and 2) providing flexibility to conduct congregational business through virtual gatherings when physical meetings cannot be held.

The Leadership Council would like to move forward with seeking congregational approval for these intermediate changes.

#### **ONLINE INFORMATIONAL MEETING NOVEMBER 8**

We are having an online informational meeting on Sunday, November 8th at 1:00 pm to explain the proposed changes and allow time for questions and answers.

**SPECIAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING NOVEMBER 15** A Special Congregational Meeting will be held on Sunday, November 15th at 10:15 am (right after the 9:00 am worship service) to vote on making the changes to the Constitution and Bylaws. This Special Congregational Meeting will be held on campus with a seating option only.

Please plan to support these important events; additional details will be provided in future communications.
