St. Timothy's is 60 years old.

I arrived in the Santa Clara Valley the same year Pastor Dan Selbo arrived at St. Timothy's to begin his tenure as Senior Pastor. The year was 1994. This was 32 years after St. Timothy's started under the leadership of Pastor Dan's father, Pastor Gordon Selbo.

Call Team Update

Dear Church Community,

Thank you so much for your prayers during this Call process.

Here is an update on what we have been doing and where we are in the Call process:

- The Call Team and congregation have met with Dean Taylor Stempniak to review our current pastor's strengths and our hopes for our new associate pastor to join our pastoral team. We also discussed areas where conflicts and sensitivities have arisen in the past.
- We have met with the past chair of the previous call process for tips and encouragement.
- We have met with the assistant to the bishop for ministry and ecumenism, Pastor Shelly Schultz, to also review the call process and to answer questions.
- We have thoroughly reviewed the Call Process manual individually and as a team.
- We have spent time in scripture reviewing suggested verses to help lead us in this process.
- We created a short questionnaire (digital and hard copies) for the congregation to share their hopes for our new Pastor as well as any other concerns.
- Based on all of this input, we are in the process of creating our Congregational Profile. Our plan is to have this posted by the end of June or beginning of July.

Our next steps are to review pastoral candidates as they become available.

SCHOLARSHIP

We are pleased to announce that St. Timothy's Lutheran Church is again offering scholarships to recent high school graduates. Scholarship recipients will receive \$1000 toward college tuition and fees, with payment made directly to the student.

ELIGIBILITY FOR SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The following criteria must be met to qualify for scholarship award under the program:

- The applicant must be affiliated with an NALC congregation within the Central Pacific Mission District or an LCMC congregation in Northern California.
- 2. The applicant must have graduated from high school within the past two years and be planning to start his or her post-secondary education during 2022.
- 3. The applicant may not have previously received a scholarship under the program.
- The applicant must return an application package (application form, an attached essay, a copy of the acceptance letter or proof of admittance from the school, and a letter of reference).
