Why is Pastor Jim gone for so long?

I will be away from St. Timothy's following worship on July 9 until I return to worship on August 13.

I have the honor of serving as the Chair of the LCMC Ministry Board. So, I will travel to Minneapolis for the summer Ministry Board meeting July 11-13. This Board serves the LCMC Association by working with all issues related to Pastoral Leadership: Seminarians, Seminaries, Call Committees (process), Pastoral Certification, Leadership Care and Development, and other issues related to pastors including possible issues of misconduct.

Then Marilyn and I will take some vacation time (July 14 - July 26). We will be able to visit Tanzania (a trip that was originally scheduled in 2020 but was delayed with the Covid Pandemic). One of the many friends who are connected through Marilyn's growing up in Madagascar operates both a Beach resort and a Safari Lodge. We will spend 4 days at each resort taking in this amazing part of God's beautiful creation. We are also looking forward to visiting the work of Courage House and the important work it does in caring for women whose lives have been deeply wounded by

exploitation and who are loved, supported, equipped and healed in and through this important and growing ministry.

On July 27 we have the honor of representing St. Timothy's on our Vision Trip with Children's Hope Chest in Ethiopia. We will visit the Ethiopian headquarters in Addis Abba before traveling to the Chapa Carepoint to visit our new friends and seeing the amazing work of development that is transforming their lives and community. (We are excited to visit in person and will bring back pictures, information and stories to share).

We will then travel back to the United States in time for me to attend Lutheran Week and the NALC Convocation in Oklahoma City August 7 -11. One of the highlights of this NALC Convocation will be the election of our Bishop. Bishop Dan Selbo and Pastor David Wendel are the two candidates for this four-year term.

I would appreciate your prayers for safe travel, refreshment and inspiration.

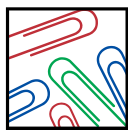

\$1000 SCHOLARSHIP

DEADLINE TO APPLY JULY 14

We are pleased to announce that St. Timothy's Lutheran Church is again offering scholarships to recent high school graduates. Scholarship recipients will receive \$1000 toward college tuition and fees, with payment made directly to the student.

ELIGIBILITY FOR SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The following criteria must be met to qualify for scholarship award under the program:

1. The applicant must be affiliated with an NALC congregation within the Central Pacific Mission District or an LCMC congregation in Northern California.
2. The applicant must have graduated from high school within the past two years and be planning to start his or her post-secondary education during 2023.
3. The applicant may not have previously received a scholarship under the program.
4. The applicant must return an application package (application form, an attached essay, a copy of the acceptance letter or proof of admittance from the school, and a letter of reference).

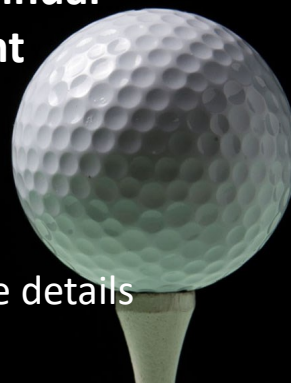

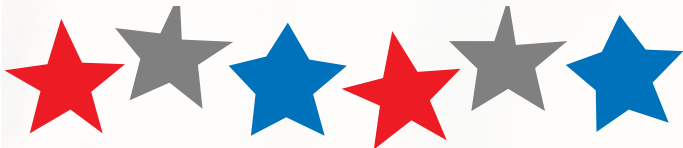
