If it is worth repeating it is certainly worth listening to.


Isaiah also reminds us in verse 54:13 "All your children shall be taught by the Lord, and great shall be the peace of your children."


And don't forget, Summer Bible Camp (VBS) is open for registration on March 1st and it is never too early to let Shelley know that you can help.






Soup does not need to be homemade but it does need to be brought hot and preferably in a crockpot/instapot.

Next step is to purchase pregnant cows and get the dairy farm up and running, using modern dairy farming methods.




